Parlick (Reception) Class Nativity will be 4pm on Monday 11th December.

The children in each class will be kept here and changed into their costumes on their allocated night by school staff. Parents and grandparents can collect any siblings (if need be) at our usual finish time of 3:30pm on the infant playground and then go straight to the school hall to watch the performance start at 4pm. No tickets will be required. Each performance will finish by 4:30pm so children can then be quickly changed and then collected from the corridor outside their classroom.
