Information for parents of children starting in Reception (Sept 2024)


New Parents' Meeting - Meeting in school hall on Monday 24th June from 2:30pm - 3:30pm for parents of children starting in Reception in Sept 24.

SCHOOL VACANCY

We are currently looking for a WELFARE ASSISTANT for 5 days per week, Monday to Friday from 12:00 noon to 1:15pm, to join our team here at St. Wilfrid's RC Primary School. This will be for 6.25 hours per week at the Foundation Living Wage rate of £12.00 per hour. The job role includes looking after the children at lunch time in the hall, serving drinks and cleaning tables and then looking after the children on the playground. Break Time provides fun group activities for children and young people aged 4-18 with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND). Activities take place after school, at weekends and during school holiday periods.

In order to access the service, parents and carers must register their child annually, usually in the autumn term. Registrations for 2024/25 closed in December 2023, however since then we have received a large number of requests from families that missed the deadline.

In response, we are pleased to announce a second opportunity to register for the current year. This will take place from 1st to 24th May 2024 and the registration form, once open, will be at: https://www.lancashire.gov.uk/children-education-families/special-educational-needs-and-disabilities/things-to-do/break-time/

Only those families that missed the original window need to complete the form at this time. ALL eligible families should re-register for 2025/26 in autumn 2024 - further updates will be shared then.

Registration for Break Time 2024/25 is reopening A second registration window will open for Break Time places from 1 May until the 24 May 2024 Parents and carers will be contacted to confirm if their registration has been successful after the closing date.
