Hospital Car Parking - Already I have had a complaint from the hospital about parents parking in the ambulance bays at the hospital. Please, please, please **DO NOT** do so even if it is just for a few seconds whilst your child jumps out. If there are no spaces you will have to continue to drive around until a vacancy on the car park is available. If parents as a collective don't adhere the hospital may ban the use of the car park by parents, which they are entitled to do and so make parking an even bigger headache for all parents.

Staff cannot "police" the parking each morning or evening, so I ask all parents to assist. If you see someone in the ambulance bays, please politely explain this message to them and explain what the potential consequences of their actions may be to all parents.
