Following the success of last year's fantastic show, we are once again auditioning for pupils to take part in this year's

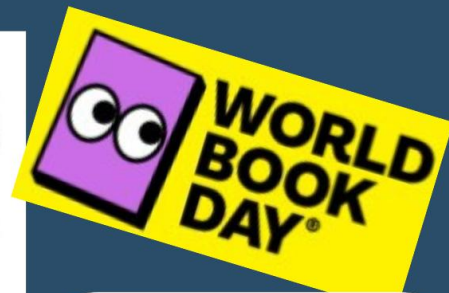
St. Wilfrid's Got Talent!

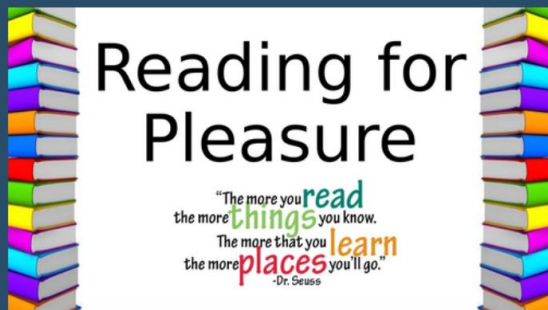
