## SCHOOL NEWS

**Y6 Health Questionnaires** – Letters have gone home regarding the Y6 health questionnaires taking place on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June. If you do not wish your child to take part please notify the school nursing team at least 3 days before this date.

**Reception and Y6 height and weight checks** - will take place on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> June. Letters went home on Wednesday. It is a negative consent so if you **do not** want your child to take part please contact the School Nursing team. Contact details are on the letter.

**Parlick Class trip to the Sealife Centre** – On Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June Parlick class will be visiting the Sealife Centre in Blackpool. The cost of this visit is £8.45 which is to be paid on ParentPay. Please can all consent forms be returned to school by the 3<sup>rd</sup> of June. Thank you.

**Staffing changes** – We say goodbye to one of our Y5 TAs, Mrs Swan, on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June. Mrs Swan has secured a full-time position at a school nearer to home. We thank her for all her efforts whilst at St Wilfrid's and wish her all the best in her new post. From September, school has appointed two new TAs, Mrs Monks, who is a familiar face due to working in Nursery, School's Out and as a Welfare Assistant in school and a Miss Hodson. I will be writing to parents shortly after our half-term break, sharing my staffing arrangements for the new school year in terms of classes and teaching personnel.

**Half-term break** - We finish today Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> May, at our usual time of 3:30pm and open again 8:55am on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June.

## Notice from LCC - Crisis and Resilience Fund

If your family is going through a hard time or facing an unexpected crisis, your local district council may be able to help.

From 1 April, the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) introduced the **Crisis and Resilience Fund (CRF)** to support local welfare services.

The fund will run until 31 March 2029 and is paid for by the UK Government.

The CRF replaces the Household Support Fund (HSF), which ran from October 2021 until 31 March 2026. **Because of this change, free school meal vouchers will no longer be available during school holidays.**

### How your district council can help

District councils can help with urgent needs such as food, essential household items and other practical support

You may want to contact your district council if you are dealing with things like:

- sudden money problems
- a family emergency that makes it hard to cover basic needs
- trouble getting food or essential household items
- a change at home that leaves you without immediate support
- extra pressure on your household budget, for example during the school holidays

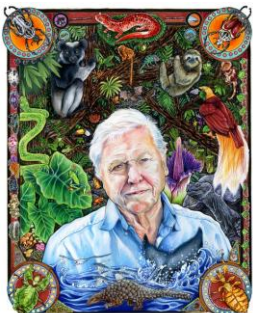
Each district has a team that can talk to you about your situation and explain what help is available in your area. This support may come directly from the council or through local community organisations.

To get help, visit your district council's website or contact them by phone.

If you are not sure which district council covers your area, you can check by entering your postcode at [www.lancashire.gov.uk/district-council](http://www.lancashire.gov.uk/district-council).

If you are already getting support from a professional, for example through a Family Hub, school, health visitor or Early Years practitioner, then they can help you to contact your district council.

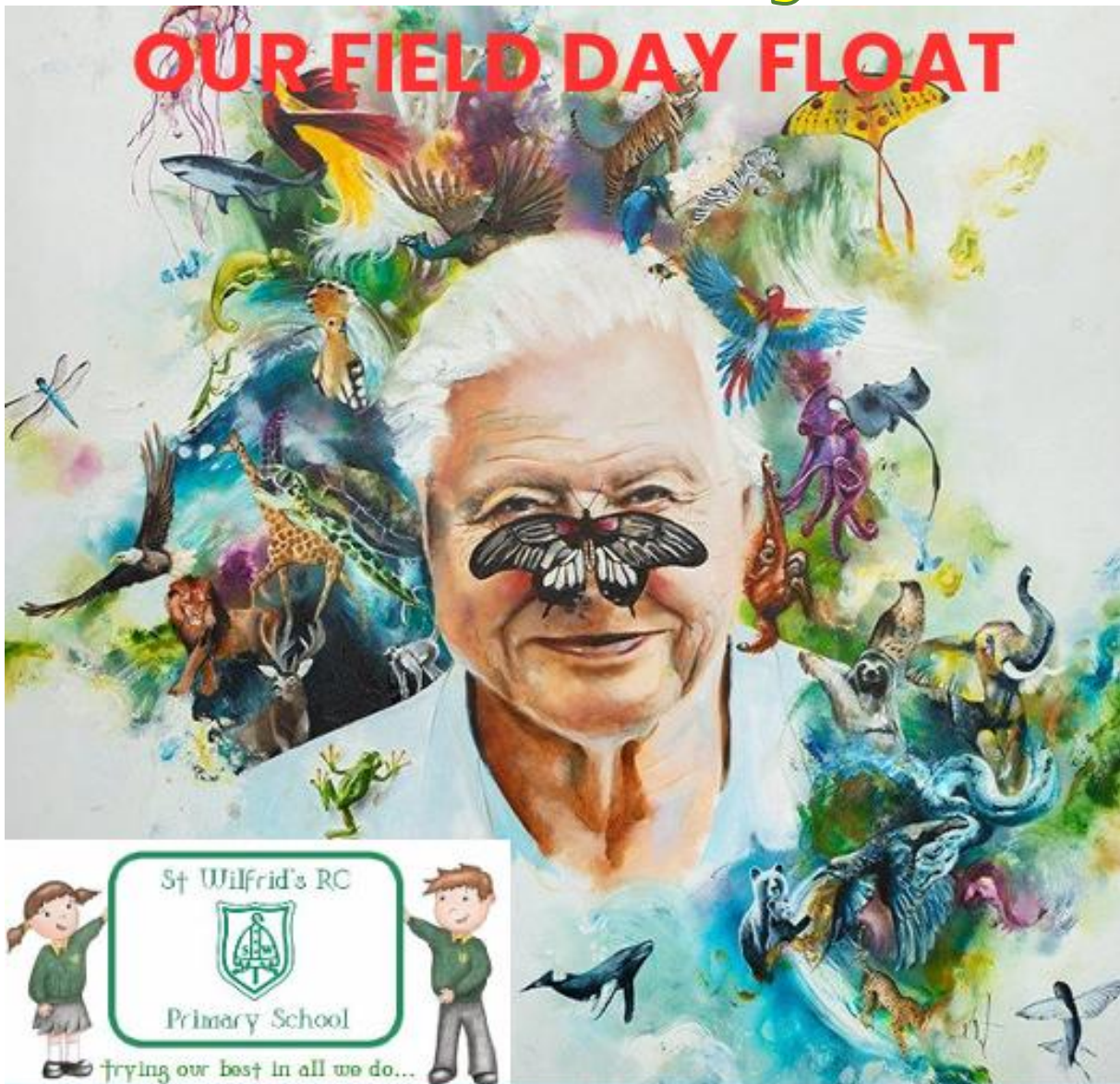
