Car Parking - I remind parents/carers/families that **the school car park is not for use** at any time including when dropping off/picking up from breakfast/after school club or school clubs. Likewise, I also remind parents that they should **not stop on the roundabout straight outside school** but park sensibly to allow children in/out of their cars. Parking on the hospital is allowed by their good grace but parents **MUST NOT** park in the ambulance bays or disabled spaces at any times. If the car park is full just drive around again until there is a space.

Earrings & Jewellery - Jewellery including earrings are not allowed at our school. If any children have had ears pierced over the summer holiday plasters need to be worn each day to cover up studs. As soon as possible the studs need to be removed. This will be strictly enforced after half-term.

Smoking including e-cigarettes is not allowed anywhere on the school site. **Dogs** are not allowed on site either.

Intimate Care Policy – If we have to wipe/clean your child at school because of a toilet accident, parents will be texted to come into school to sign a form.

New Contact details – Please update the school office with any new mobile/email contact details.

Nasal Flu Immunisations – Consent forms went home last week. Please contact the office if you have not received a form. Vaccinations will take place on Friday 1st December 2023. **However, consent forms need to be completed and sent back to school by Monday 18th September.** Even if you do not want your child to have the vaccination please fill in the back of the form stating you do not consent and return the form to school. Thank you.

Reminder term time holidays - Please take holidays in our published breaks otherwise school **will** ask LCC to impose a fixed penalty notice for 10 or more unauthorised sessions (just 5 days) each term.

Absences – If your child is not going to be in school, please notify the office by 9.30am. After this time if we have not been contacted the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. If your child is off school due to sickness and diarrhoea please make sure they have 48 hours free of symptoms before sending back to school. Thank you.

Head lice – We have had reports of head lice. Please check your child's hair on a regular basis and treat if nits are found.
