**Reminder term time holidays** - Please take holidays in our published breaks otherwise school <u>will</u> ask LCC to impose a fixed penalty notice for 10 or more unauthorised sessions (just 5 days) each term.

**Absences** – If your child is not going to be in school, please notify the office by 9.30am. After this time if we have not been contacted the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. If you child is off school due to sickness and diarrhoea, please make sure they have 48 hours free of symptoms before sending back to school. Thank you.

**Data Collection Sheets –** Will be going home tonight. Please check the form, sign it and return to school asap. If any of the details are incorrect please amend. Thank you.

**Head lice** – We have had reports of head lice. Please check your child's hair on a regular basis and treat if nits are found.
