

Dear Parents,

Each Summer at St Wilfrid's we give the children the challenge of creating a 'Summer Project'. This year, we are sending the information out a little earlier than usual to allow families to make a start whilst they may be at home!

Your child can complete their project on a topic of their own choice eg Space, gymnastics, CBeebies, in fact absolutely anything they want! They may present their project in any way they wish, be it a folder, scrapbook, booklet, poster or a creative idea of their own. However, we have sent a book home this week which the children can use if they wish.

We do expect the children to include some writing in the project, be it some short paragraphs of information, some sentences or some written labels. With their writing they may choose to add some artwork or draw some pictures, or they may like to add a model or photographs, something they have grown or made. The choice is theirs! We expect you as parents to help, guide and work alongside your child but not to do the work for them.

Over the past years we have had projects about growing butterflies, gardening, sporting activities, places, holidays, trips out, favourite hobbies, children's families and even baking...all sorts of creative things! The choice is yours!

There are four prizes awarded for the projects in each class – the best overall, the most creative, the best effort and the best presentation.

We do expect **all** children to do a little bit of work building up their project each week and hand in a completed project by the deadline, which will be sometime in the final half term!

We hope you enjoy creating the project with your child and we all (Miss Braithwaite, Mrs Mallinder and Mrs Pollard) look forward to seeing the variety of projects that are brought in!
