### **CORONA VIRUS CV19 MESSAGES**

In light of the latest advices from LCC school will no longer insist that children with any symptoms get a negative PCR test result before they come back to school. However, we would still encourage you to take your child for a PCR test.

From now on, siblings/childcare bubbles will not need to isolate and even a tested child can come back to school if well enough whilst you await the result. If your child doesn't have one of the classic 3 Covid symptoms (temperature, cough or change/loss of taste/smell) but is still ill, you need to select the option 'You've been asked to get a test by a local council' to book your PCR test for them.

As you can see, advice is changing on a weekly basis. If you are unsure what to do when your child is unwell please contact school for further advice.
