CORONA VIRUS CV19 MESSAGES

Please notify school immediately of any suspected/confirmed cases of CV-19.

I know from speaking to the Headteachers of both Barnacre and Longridge CE (Berry Lane) that they too, like St Wilfrid's, are currently experiencing high numbers of children testing positive for CV19. Rates in our area are obviously high. The current situation is that as soon as there is any positive case in a class, all parents of children in that class will be contacted and be advised to take their child for a PCR test, even if they have no symptoms, as they may be a close contact. Please, please, please follow this advice and book them in for a PCR test even if they have no symptoms as they are classed as a close contact. Home tests (Lateral flows) are not that accurate and nor advised for primary aged pupils so I repeat please help to keep us all as safe as possible and book a PCR test if advised. If your child has recently had a positive test for CV19 there is no need to re-test them. If children have no symptoms then they can still attend school whilst they are waiting for a test result. If your child has symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), they should get a PCR test and remain at home at least until the result is known. Any child who tests positive must isolate for 10 days.
